CERTIFICATE.

Montreal, 15th November 1913

Abraham Blumenthal of the City and District of Montreal,

Merchant on the 15 day of November 1913

subscribed, and took, before me, the oaths of residence and allegiance au-
thorized by the thirteenth section of "The Naturalization Act," and
therein swore to a residence in Canada of nine years : that
I have reason to believe, and I do believe, that the said

Harry Mendelsohn
within the period of nine years preceding the said day, has been a
resident within Canada for nine years that the said
Harry Mendelsohn
is a person of good character, and that there exists to my knowledge, no
reason why the said Harry Mendelsohn
should not be granted all the rights and capacities of a natural-born Bri-
tish subject.

Oath of Allegiance.

(Revised Statutes of Canada, 1906, Chapter 77, Section 13.)

I, Harry Mendelsohn 22 years

formerly of The A. of Chernovitz Province
Bukovina Austria
and known there by the name of Harry Mendelsohn
and now residing in the City of Montreal, District of Montreal P.Q., in Canada
Merchant
(Occupation)

do sincerely promise and swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance
to His Majesty King George V as lawful Sovereign of the United Kingdom
of Great Britain and Ireland, and of the Dominion of Canada, dependent on
and belonging to the said Kingdom, and that I will defend Him to the utmost
of my power against all traitorous conspiracies, or attempts whatsoever which
shall be made against His Person Crown and Dignity, and that I will do my
utmost endeavor to disclose and make known to His Majesty, His Heirs or Suc-
cessors, all treasons or traitorous conspiracies and attempts which I shall know
to be against Him or any of them; and all this I do swear without any equivo-
cation, mental evasion or secret reservation. So help me God.

for more than three consecutive years preceding this date, to wit, for
nine years, with intent to settle therein.

That your Petitioner has duly taken the oaths of residence and alle-
giance as the whole will more fully appear by reference to the said oaths
and the certificate of *Abraham Blumenthal Insurance Broker*
of the City and District of Montreal, an officer duly authorized to take
oaths under the Naturalization Act herewith filed to form part hereof.

WHEREFORE your Petitioner prays that he be naturalized a Bri-
tish Subject, and that all the rights and capacities of a natural born Bri-
tish Subject be granted to him, and that a certificate of Naturalization,
showing that your Petitioner has complied with all the requirements of
law, be issued.

And your Petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray.
